The mission of the GCHMCC is to provide assistance and resources to its membership in their efforts to mitigate the impact of pollution releases, and to promote maritime security awareness in and along the Ohio River and its surrounding tributaries which affect the Greater Cincinnati Ohio region. SPILL RESPONSE TRAILER

It is also more accessible for members to connect and transport to their facility as well as providing a great deal more equipment stored than the previous trailer. This trailer was purchased with dues collected from all the members of the GCHMCC and is made available to all members in the event of a spill.
