SPILL RESPONSE TRAILER

The GCHMCC has purchased and outfitted a new 7'x 14' enclosed spill response trailer. It will provide easier access to the equipment, PPE, and minimize hassle of the boom deployment from the trailer. It is also more accessible for members to connect and transport to their facility as well as providing a great deal more equipment stored than the previous trailer. This trailer was purchased with dues collected from all the members of the GCHMCC and is made available to all members in the event of a spill. The GCHMCC would like to give special thanks to the companies, who donated supplies and money for new and up-dated equipment.
