American Red Cross Flood Cleanup Kits Available

Hamilton County, OH –To assist Hamilton County residents affected by the recent flooding, the American Red Cross, in coordination with Hamilton County and various nonprofit partners, will open a distribution site for flood cleanup kits at the **Ebersole Recreation Center, 5701 Kellogg Ave., Cincinnati, OH 45230**, on **Friday, March 2, 2018** from **10 a.m.- 6 p.m.** Flood cleanup kits will be also available for pickup on **Saturday, March 3, 2018** from **10 a.m.- 6 p.m.**

A flood cleanup kit contains the following materials: bleach, cleanser, dust masks, heavy duty gloves, scrub brushes, 1 long-handled sink brush, sponges, mop, garbage bags, and a 5-gallon bucket. Snacks, water, and a boxed lunch will also be available for residents picking up a cleanup kit.
