EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT ON MITIGATION PLAN

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – In an effort to make Hamilton County more disaster ready and resistant, Hamilton County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (EMHSA) is seeking public feedback on the 2018 Hamilton County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. This plan serves as a guide to the County in how to become more resilient to the impacts of natural and technological hazards. Interested residents have until April 27, 2018 to view and make comments on the Plan before it is submitted to FEMA for review.

“Hamilton County is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of its residents and the reduction of disaster-related damages from both natural and manmade hazards,” Nick Crossley, Hamilton County EMHSA Director said. “The public’s participation will assist our emergency preparedness staff in identifying which hazards are of most concern to our residents and businesses.
