The University of Findlay's All Hazards Training Center presents the U. S. Coast Guard-accepted Facility Security Officer course. This class is a course of training for individuals tasked with the role of Facility Security Officer for facilities subject to 33 CFR 105 and addresses the competencies required in 33 CFR 105.205, including:

- The security assessment process and developing security plans and implementing security measures
- Conducting drills and exercises
- International and US codes and regulations
- Security equipment and systems, including the Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)
- Dangerous substances and devices
- Characteristics of persons who threaten security

The class aligns with and is based on the IMO Model Course 3.21, the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS), 33 CFR, and the guidelines set forth in the U.S. Coast Guard Navigation and Vessel Inspection Circulars and relevant policy guidance– **U.S. COAST GUARD ACCEPTED**
