### Outdoor Warning Siren System Short Test Today

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – The Hamilton County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (EMHSA) will conduct a **brief, 10-second sounding** of the Outdoor Warning Siren System today, **June 12, 2019 at 12:00pm**. The regular June test of the sirens was rescheduled for today due to last Wednesday's inclement weather.

There are three basic criteria to activate the sirens:

- The National Weather Service issues a Tornado Warning for all or part of Hamilton County,
- A tornado is reported by a local public safety official; or
- A dangerous situation occurs which requires citizens to seek shelter immediately.
