Description:

The purpose of this course is to provide an orientation to the Incident Command System (ICS) for Executives and Senior Officials (including elected officials, city/county managers, agency administrators, etc.). The National Incident Management System provides a comprehensive and consistent national approach to all-hazard incident management at all jurisdictional levels and across all functional emergency management disciplines. Since most incidents occur and are handled by local government, the support of elected and appointed officials in the NIMS implementation process is crucial to the nation's success in preventing, preparing for, responding to and recovering from disasters – regardless of their cause. The NIMS necessitates the use of the Incident Command System, the multi-agency coordination systems and a public information system. All these command and management systems rely on the direct involvement of elected and appointed officials in a community during an incident.
