### **September Outdoor Warning Siren System Test TODAY**

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – The Hamilton County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (EMHSA) will be conducting the regular test of the Outdoor Warning Siren System today, **September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 at 12:00pm**. The outdoor warning sirens in Hamilton County are tested the first Wednesday of each month at noon unless inclement weather is imminent.

It is important for members of the public to remember that the Outdoor Warning are not meant to be heard indoors. Hamilton County residents should have multiple ways to be notified of severe weather alerts, including having a NOAA Weather Radio and downloading trustworthy weather apps.
