June Outdoor Warning Siren System Test Rescheduled

HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO – The Hamilton County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (EMHSA) **will not be testing** the Outdoor Warning Siren System on **June 2nd, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.** The June siren test is **rescheduled for Wednesday, June 9th** at noon, pending weather conditions. The rescheduled test on June 9th will last approximately **10 seconds**.

There are three basic criteria to activate the sirens:

- The National Weather Service issues a Tornado Warning for all or part of Hamilton County,
- A tornado is reported by a local public safety official; or
- A dangerous situation occurs which requires the public to seek shelter indoors immediately.
